On an annual basis, the average American teacher spends \$513 out of their own pocket on classroom supplies for their students. In NAFC, there are approximately 690 teachers; that's over \$350,000 in school supplies being bought by our teachers every single year.

We know the exceptional educators in NAFC schools give all they can to make sure their students succeed. To help them along in their efforts, we are proud to offer the opportunity for any educator in the district to apply for up to \$500 a year in Great Classroom Project funding. These projects are used to provide additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms.

Examples of past projects funded are:

- Interactive technology like iPads, e-readers, and document cameras
- Books and audio recordings for students with special needs
- Frogs for dissecting in science classrooms
- Printing press for art rooms
- CD based foreign language learning system
- Water basketball goals for health and fitness training
- Web based learning plans for students with disabilities
- Music books, music stands, and interactive SMART Board software for music rooms
- Yoga mats for yoga instruction and training in Health and PE curriculum

In the 2014-2015 school year the Foundation funded \$75,000 in Great Classroom Projects. In only five years the Education Foundation has funded over \$350,000 in classroom resources and more than 700 individual classroom projects.

Imagination Library

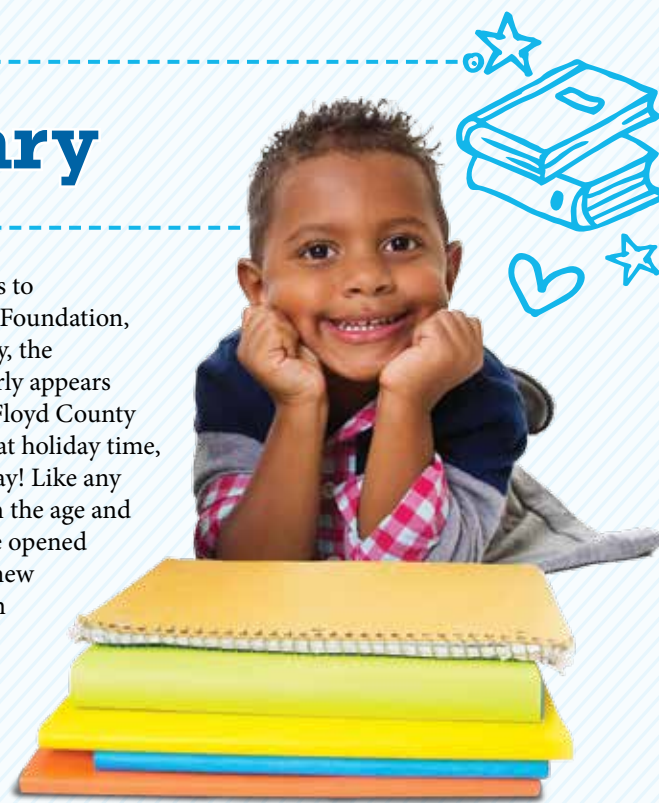

Junior Achievement

Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana is the region's leading provider of life-changing economics programs for students. All NAFC students are sent through JA curriculum in memory of James B. Robinson.

In recent years students have demonstrated an alarming decrease in their understanding of basic economic principals. Additionally, employers report widespread decline in basic employment skills and government reports give further evidence of the diminishing ability among young people to manage personal finances.

During the 2014-2015 school year, the entire 5th grade student body, about 950 students, participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown and the entire 7th grade student body, about 925 students, participated in JA Finance Park through funding from the Education Foundation. The Education Foundation is proud to send our young entrepreneurs through this program every year.

JA BizTown is a creative hands-on program designed to respond to employer and community leader concerns that students lack basic understanding of the economics and life skills needed for future roles in the workplace. The program combines a four-week classroom curriculum with a state-of-the-art interactive free enterprise laboratory located in Louisville. The JA BizTown experience helps students learn and apply rigorous academic standards in math, civics, social studies, language arts and technology as 5th grade students play real life roles as citizens of their very own mini town.

JA Finance Park is a month-long economics education program that introduces personal financial planning and career exploration to 8th grade students. Classroom teachers deliver financial literacy basics during a four-week period, then students visit JA Finance Park to put into practice what they've learned about economic options and the principles of budgeting. Assisted by their teachers and a staff of trained volunteers, they have the opportunity to actually develop and commit to a personal budget.

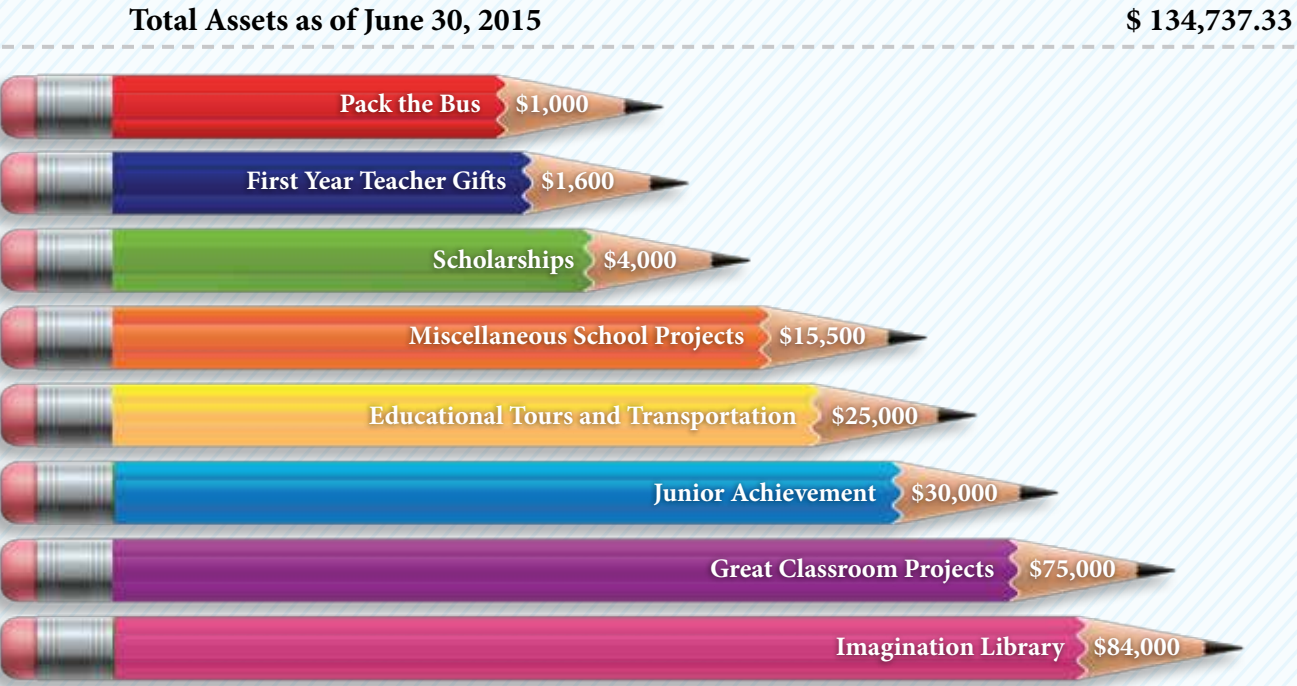
