Classroom Transformations – Energized by YOU

Great Classroom Projects ... On an annual basis, the average American teacher spends \$513 out of their own pocket on classroom supplies for their students. In NAFC, there are approximately 690 teachers; that's over \$350,000 in school supplies being bought by our educators every single year.

We know the exceptional educators in NAFC schools give all they can to make sure their students succeed. To help them along in their efforts, we are proud to offer the opportunity for any educator in the district to apply for up to \$500 a year in Great Classroom Project funding. These projects are used to provide additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms.

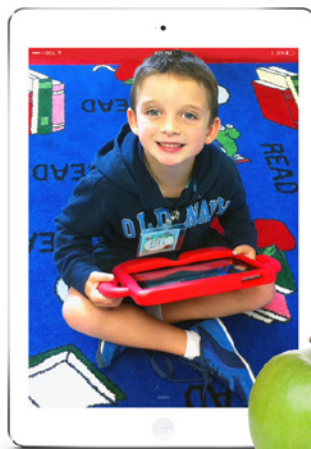
Examples of past projects funded are:

- Interactive technology like iPads, e-readers, and document cameras
- Guided reading books
- Frogs for dissecting in science classrooms
- Printing press for art rooms
- CD based foreign language learning system
- Water basketball goals for health and fitness training
- Books, audio recordings, and web based learning plans for students with disabilities
- Music books, music stands, and interactive SMART Board software for music rooms
- Yoga mats for yoga instruction and training in Health and PE curriculum

A Lifelong Love of Reading – Ignited by YOU

Imagination Library ... A lifelong love of reading begins in the coziest of circumstances. Picture a young child sitting on the lap of mom or dad or another caring adult as they read a book together. Cozy, indeed, but such a powerful interaction. In that simple act a spark is ignited. A lifelong love of reading begins. With daily family reading time the parent fans the flame until the child eventually reads alone for enjoyment and learning.



Developing a lifelong love of reading takes commitment from families and resources to purchase books. Thanks to the generosity of our community, children throughout Floyd County are developing a love of books and reading that will last a lifetime. Through the Dolly Parton Imagination Library of Floyd County, over 3,400 children under the age of five receive a new book in their mailboxes each month, at no cost to the family. Children get to keep the books. And what books they are! Books that tell wonderful stories of places far away. Books that produce a giggle, or an “ahh” of appreciation. Books that share new words and new experiences in an ever-expanding life of a child. Even more, on the back flap of the books, parents will find reading tips that help them engage the child in early skill development that provides a strong foundation for success in school. And you, with your generous support of the New Albany-Floyd County Education Foundation, ignited the spark for a lifelong love of reading!

Hungry Mouths Fed – Because of YOU

Blessings in a Backpack ... This year, the NAFC Education Foundation became an official partner with the Floyd County Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack. This group of volunteers is dedicated to making Floyd County a “hunger free zone” for all elementary school children. In conjunction with the national Blessings in a Backpack organization, the Floyd County Chapter aims to make sure that nearly 2,000 NAFC school children who rely on the federal free and reduced lunch program for their weekly meals, don’t go hungry on the weekend when school is closed. Blessings in a Backpack operates at all 9 of the NAFC elementary schools and at Children’s Academy Early Learning Center.

Once a week for 38 weeks of the school year, volunteers pack backpacks of food to send home with eligible NAFC students. **For as little as \$2.11 per weekend, donors can provide a hunger-free weekend to a child.** A backpack of food includes:

- Two entrees, such as ravioli and spaghetti and meatballs.
- Two breakfasts, such as cereal and shelf stable milk.
- Two snacks, such as crackers, soy butter and sliced fruit cup.

This food keeps hunger pangs at bay so the students can return to school Monday morning nourished and ready to learn. However, the impact goes beyond that day. Student survey results show that children fed by Blessings in a Backpack experience the following impact on their lives:

- 78% feel cared for by their community.
- 71% feel they are helping their family.
- 60% do not get in trouble as much.
- 59% find it is easier to learn at school.

Junior Achievement ... Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana is the region's leading provider of life-changing economics programs for students. In recent years students have demonstrated an alarming decrease in their understanding of basic economic principles. Additionally, employers report widespread decline in basic employment skills and government reports give further evidence of the diminishing ability among young people to manage personal finances.

During the 2015-2016 school year, the entire 5th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown and the entire 7th grade student body, about 850 students, participated in JA Finance Park through funding from the Education Foundation. Each program combines a multi-week classroom curriculum with a visit to the state-of-the-art interactive free enterprise laboratory located in Louisville. The Education Foundation is proud to send our young entrepreneurs through this program every year.

JA BizTown is a creative hands-on program which teaches basic understanding of the economics and life skills needed for future roles in the workplace.

JA Finance Park introduces personal financial planning and career exploration.

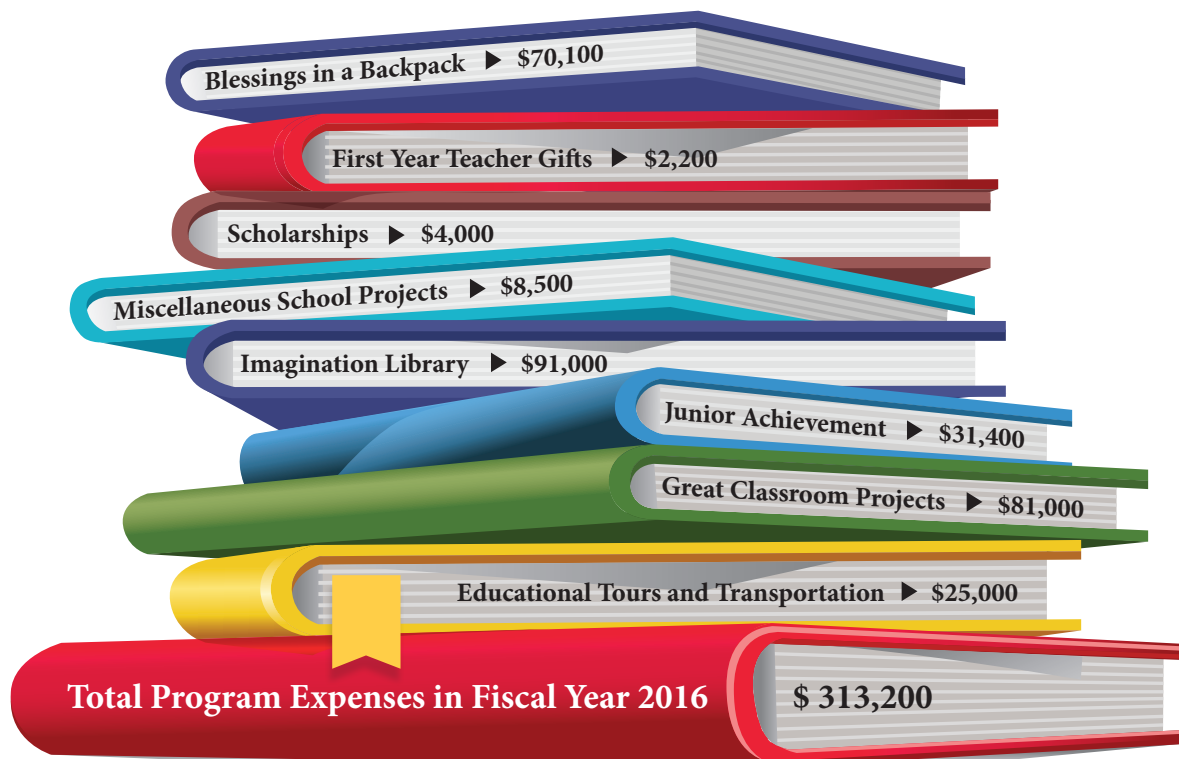
Continued Education – Thanks to YOU
