We know the exceptional educators in NAFC schools give all they can to make sure their students succeed. To help them along in their effort, we are proud to offer the opportunity for any educator in the district to apply for up to \$500 a year in Great Classroom Project funding. These projects are used to provide additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms.

In the 2016-2017 school year the Foundation funded \$80,000 in Great Classroom Projects with more than 860 individual classroom projects!

GREEN LIGHTING a Love of Reading



A lifelong love of reading begins in the coziest of circumstances. Picture a young child sitting on the lap of mom or dad or another caring adult as they read a book together. Cozy, indeed, but such a powerful interaction. In that simple act a spark is ignited. A lifelong love of reading begins. With daily family reading time the parent fans the flame until the child eventually reads alone for enjoyment and learning.

Developing a lifelong love of reading takes commitment from families and resources to purchase books. Thanks to the generosity of our community, children throughout Floyd County are developing a love of books and reading that will last a lifetime. Through the Dolly Parton Imagination Library of Floyd County, over 3,400 children under the age of five receive a new book in their mailboxes each month, at no cost to the family. Children get to keep the books.

And what books they are! Books that tell wonderful stories of places far away. Books that produce a giggle, or an “ahh” of appreciation. Books that share new words and new experiences in an ever-expanding life of a child. Even more, on the back flap of the books, parents will find reading tips that help them engage the child in early skill development that provides a strong foundation for success in school. FUELING Successful Learners

The NAFC Education Foundation is an official partner with the Floyd County Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack. This group of volunteers is dedicated to making Floyd County a “hunger free zone” for all elementary school children. In conjunction with the national Blessings in a Backpack organization, the Floyd County Chapter aims to make sure that approximately 1,200 NAFC school children who rely on the federal free and reduced lunch program for their weekly meals, don’t go hungry on the weekend when school is closed.

Once a week for 38 weeks of the school year, volunteers pack backpacks of food to send home with eligible NAFC students. **For as little as \$100 a year, donors can provide hunger-free weekends to a child.**

This food keeps hunger pangs at bay so the students can return to school Monday morning nourished and ready to learn. However, the impact goes beyond that day. Student survey results show that children fed by Blessings in a Backpack experience the following impact on their lives:

- 78% feel cared for by their community.
- 71% feel they are helping their family.
- 60% do not get in trouble as much.
- 59% find it is easier to learn at school.

Floyd County is the only community in the country that has made the commitment to make the entire county a hunger free zone, providing Blessings in a Backpack across all 9 elementary schools and Children’s Academy Early Learning Center.

Racing Toward Career READINESS



Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana is the region's leading provider of life-changing economics programs for students. In recent years students

have demonstrated an alarming decrease in their understanding of basic economic principles. Additionally, employers report widespread decline in basic employment skills and government reports give further evidence of the diminishing ability among young people to manage personal finances.

During the 2016-2017 school year, the entire 5th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown and the entire 7th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in JA Finance Park through funding from the Education Foundation. The Education Foundation is proud to send our young entrepreneurs through this program every year.

JA BizTown is a creative hands-on program designed to respond to employer and community leader concerns that students lack basic understanding of the economics and life skills needed for future roles in the workplace. The program combines a four-week classroom curriculum with a state-of-the-art interactive free enterprise laboratory located in Louisville where students play real life roles as citizens of their very own mini town.

JA Finance Park is a month-long economics education program that introduces personal financial planning and career exploration to 8th grade students. Classroom teachers deliver financial literacy basics during a four-week period, then students visit JA Finance Park to put into practice what they've learned about economic options and the principles of budgeting.

All NAFCS students are sent through Junior Achievement in memory of James Robinson.

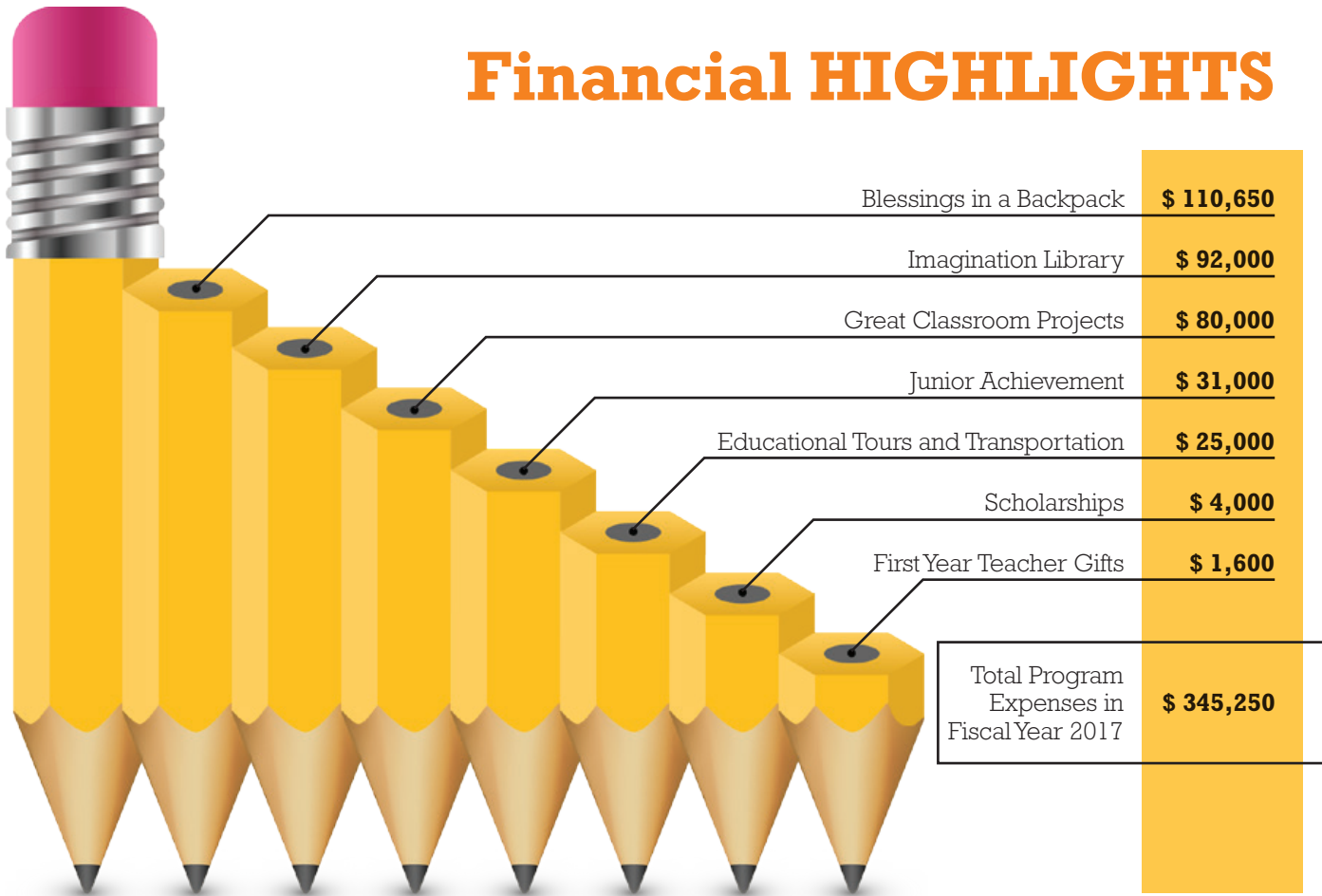
YIELD for Raising Stars
