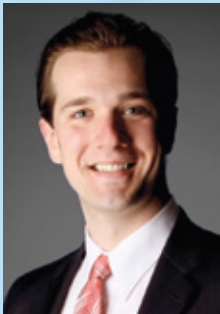

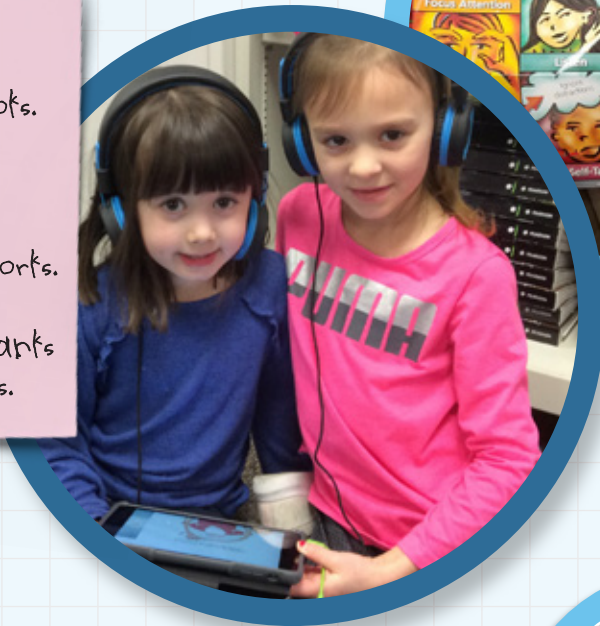
Great Classroom PROJECTS

We know the exceptional educators in NAFC schools give all they can to make sure their students succeed. To help them along in their effort, we are proud to offer the opportunity for any educator in the district to apply for up to \$500 a year in Great Classroom Project funding. These projects are used to provide additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms.

In the 2018-2019 school year the Foundation funded \$90,000 in Great Classroom Projects with more than 180 individual classroom projects. Over \$800,000 to date!

Junior ACHIEVEMENT

Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana is the region's leading provider of life-changing economics programs for students. During the 2018-2019 school year, the entire 5th grade



student body, about 900 students, participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown and the entire 7th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in JA Finance Park through funding from the Education Foundation. The Education Foundation is proud to send our young entrepreneurs through this program every year.

JA BizTown is a state-of-the art interactive free enterprise laboratory located in Louisville where students play real life roles as citizens of their very own mini town.

JA Finance Park is a month-long economics education program which culminates with a visit to a simulated city where students put into practice what they've learned about economic options and the principles of budgeting.

All NAFCS students are sent through Junior Achievement in memory of James Robinson.

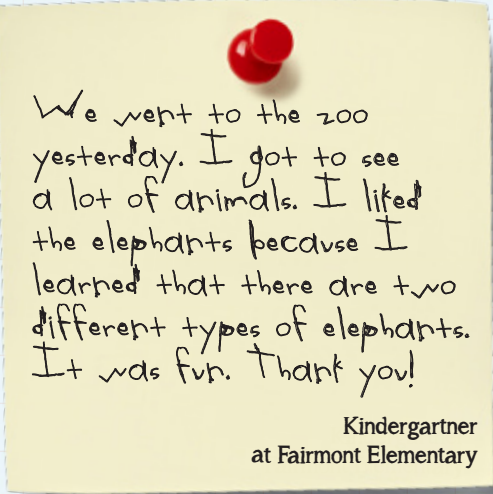
Educational TOURS

Great Arts PROJECTS

We were proud to partner, for the second year, with the Fund for the Arts to offer \$10,000 in new grant funding to bring arts experiences into NAFC classrooms. Through this funding, community arts partners like Commonwealth Theatre, Louisville Visual Arts, Center Stage, KMAC, and Kentucky Shakespeare were able to bring high quality arts experiences into our schools. We were pleased to share 23 new arts experiences this year!



Blessings in a Backpack

Feeding The Future Of America®

The NAFC Education Foundation is an official partner with the Floyd County Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack. This group of volunteers is dedicated to making Floyd County a “hunger free zone” for all elementary school children. In conjunction with the national Blessings in a Backpack organization, the Floyd County Chapter aims to make sure that approximately 1,200 NAFC school children who rely on the federal free and reduced lunch program for their weekly meals, don’t go hungry on the weekend when school is closed.

Once a week for 38 weeks of the school year, volunteers pack backpacks of food to send home with eligible NAFC students. This food keeps hunger pangs at bay so the students can return to school Monday morning nourished and ready to learn. However, the impact goes beyond that day. **For as little as \$100 a year, donors can provide hunger-free weekends to a child.**

Floyd County is the only community in the country that has made the commitment to make the entire county a hunger free zone, providing Blessings in a Backpack across all 9 Elementary Schools and Children’s Academy Early Learning Center.

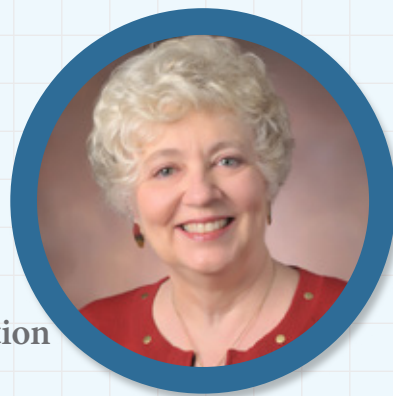
The New Albany Floyd County Education Foundation is an independent fundraising organization providing impactful resources and experiences to the students and teachers of Floyd County public schools.

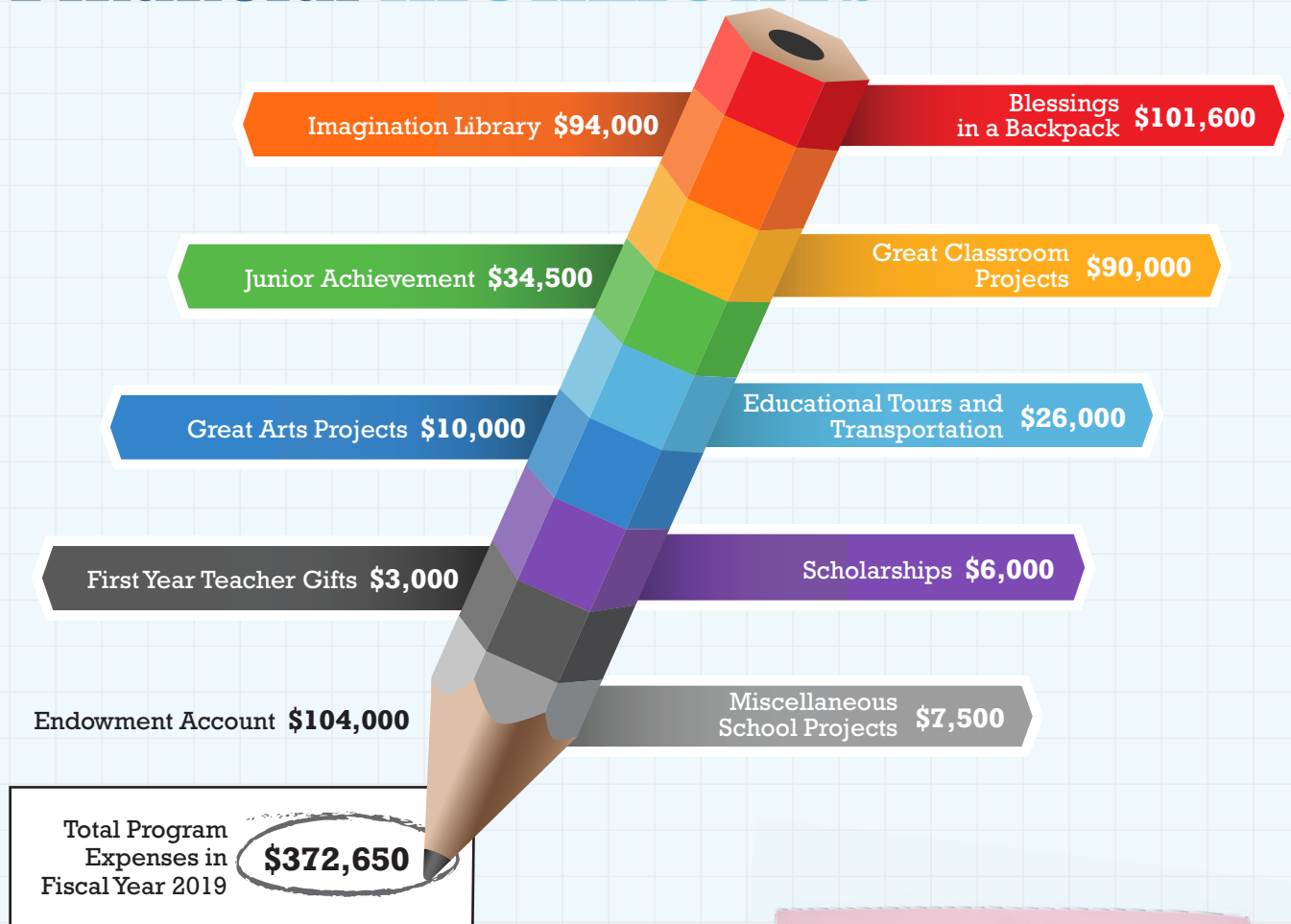
