We know the exceptional educators in NAFC schools give all they can to make sure their students succeed. To help them along in their effort, we are proud to offer the opportunity for any educator in the district to apply for up to \$500 a year in Great Classroom Project funding. These projects are used to provide additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms.

JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT

Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana is the region's leading provider of life-changing economics programs for students. During the 2019-2020 school year, the entire 5th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown and the entire 7th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in JA Finance Park through funding from the Education Foundation. The Education Foundation is proud to send our young entrepreneurs through this program every year.

JA BizTown is a state-of-the-art interactive free enterprise laboratory located in Louisville where students play real life roles as

JA Finance Park is a month-long economics education program which culminates with a visit to a simulated city where students put into practice what they've learned about economic options and the principles of budgeting.

Celebrating its 10th birthday in October 2019, Dolly Parton's Imagination Library of Floyd County continues to give the gift of reading to the children of our community.

Each month a book in the mailbox of participating children signals hours of family reading. Each book takes the child closer to becoming an independent reader and a lifelong learner who loves books. Each community organization who supports the program through funding, promotion or registration insures the sustainability of this program. Each parent who regularly reads an Imagination Library book to a child prepares him or her to be ready to take that all important first step into the kindergarten classroom.



EDUCATIONAL TOURS

The Foundation is proud to provide funding to elementary students for admission and transportation to numerous educational tours to local historical and cultural experiences. This past year, due to unexpected early closings, our elementary students were only able to make trip to the Louisville Zoo, Ogle Center, and Division

GREAT ARTS PROJECTS

We were proud to partner, for the third year, with the Fund for the Arts to offer \$10,000 in new grant funding to bring arts experiences into NAFC classrooms. Through this funding, community arts partners like Commonwealth Theatre, Louisville Visual Arts, Center Stage, Commonwealth Theatre, and Kentucky Shakespeare were able to bring high quality arts experiences into our schools. We were pleased to share 13 new arts experiences this year!

Blessings in a Backpack Feeding The Future Of America



The NAFC Education Foundation is an official partner with the Floyd County Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack. This group of volunteers is dedicated to making Floyd County a "hunger free zone" for all elementary school children. In conjunction with the national Blessings in a Backpack organization, the Floyd County Chapter aims to make sure that approximately 1,600 NAFC school children who rely on the federal free and reduced lunch program for their weekly meals, don't go hungry on the weekend when school is closed.

Once a week for 40 weeks of the school year, volunteers pack backpacks of food to send home with eligible NAFC students. This food keeps hunger pangs at bay so the students can return to school Monday morning nourished and ready to learn. **\$105 a year will provide hunger-free weekends to a child in need.**


Floyd County's Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack is one of the largest in the country, having made the commitment to create a county-wide hunger free zone by providing food to pre-K through 4th grade students in need at all 9 elementary schools, Children's Academy Early Learning Center, and 5th grade students at all 3 middle schools.

1ST YEAR TEACHER GIFTS

Many Education majors finish college and move into their first positions as teachers with little to no help. Can you imagine being responsible for purchasing the numerous supplies and material needed for a classroom with 20-30 students? This is

why the Education Foundation chose to award 40 educators, new to NAFCS, with \$100 gift cards for education supplies. Teachers face hundreds of dollars in out of pocket expenses to provide for their students. The Education Foundation is proud to facilitate a smoother transition into becoming a NAFC educator.
