105,000 FREE Books sent to Floyd County Children through Imagination Library



Can you imagine the excitement of a child racing to the mailbox to discover a new book mailed personally to them? That scene is repeated month after month by approximately 3,060 Floyd County children who are enrolled in the Imagination Library Project.

Any child from birth to age five who lives in Floyd County, Indiana is eligible to participate. Registration forms are available at the New Albany-Floyd County Public Library, distributed through NA-FC Schools, Head Start, Hispanic Ministries of Southern Indiana, Indiana University Southeast,

Success By Six, child care homes and centers, churches and many community organizations and businesses. You can register completely free online at www.imaginationlibrary.com, or by calling the Imagination Library office at 542-4001 to receive a form by mail. By doing so, your child will receive a beautiful, age appropriate book in the mail every single month until their fifth birthday. Over 105,000 books have been distributed in Floyd County since the program began nearly four years ago.

The annual cost of one child's participation in Imagination Library is \$30. A whole month of books for all registered children is approximately \$6,000.
