\$72,000 in Great Classroom Projects Awarded in 2011-2012 School Year



Last month our Board of Directors approved \$14,585 to fund Great Classroom Projects for the month of March. If you are not familiar with this initiative, a Great Classroom Project provides additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms. Any teacher in NAFCS may apply for up to \$500 to fund a project in their classroom. This year we received a record number of applications and reallocated extra funds to bring this year's giving total for Great Classroom Projects to \$72,000!!! Total funding given to this initiative is \$131,000 to date. We would like to thank our incredible teachers who applied and received funding. Their commitment to improving our classrooms and quality of education for our students is so appreciated.
