Great Classroom PROJECTS

To help them along in their efforts, we are proud to offer the opportunity for any educator in the district to apply for up to \$500 a year in Great Classroom Project funding. These projects are used to provide additional resources to creative teachers for learning opportunities that enhance the educational and curricular objectives of their classrooms.



In the 2017-2018 school year the Foundation funded \$85,000 in Great Classroom Projects with more than 170 individual classroom projects!

Junior ACHIEVEMENT

Junior Achievement of Kentuckiana is the region's leading provider of life-changing economics programs for students. During the 2016-2017 school year, the entire 5th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in Junior Achievement's BizTown and the entire 7th grade student body, about 900 students, participated in JA Finance Park through funding from the Education Foundation.



JA BizTown is a creative hands-on program designed to respond to employer and community leader concerns that students lacked basic understanding of the economics and life skills needed for future roles in the workplace. The program combines a four-week classroom curriculum with a state-of-the art interactive free enterprise laboratory located in Louisville where students play real life roles as citizens of their very own mini town.

JA Finance Park is a month-long economics education program that introduces personal financial planning and career exploration to 8th grade students. Classroom teachers deliver financial literacy basics during a four-week period, then students visit JA Finance Park to put into practice what they've learned about economic options and the principles of budgeting.

All NAFCS students are sent through Junior Achievement in memory of James Robinson.

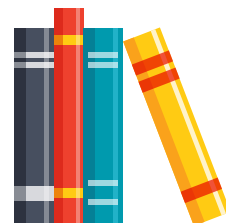


Imagination LIBRARY

Great Arts PROJECTS

Blessings in a Backpack[®]

Feeding The Future Of America

The NAFC Education Foundation is an official partner with the Floyd County Chapter of Blessings in a Backpack. This group of volunteers is dedicated to making Floyd County a “hunger free zone” for all elementary school children. In conjunction with the national Blessings in a Backpack organization, the Floyd County Chapter aims to make sure that approximately 1,200 NAFC school children who rely on the federal free and reduced lunch program for their weekly meals don’t go hungry on the weekend when school is closed.

Once a week for 38 weeks of the school year, volunteers pack backpacks of food to send home with eligible NAFC students. This food keeps hunger pangs at bay so the students can return to school Monday morning nourished and ready to learn. However, the impact goes beyond that day. **For as little as \$100 a year, donors can provide hunger-free weekends to a child.**

Floyd County is the only community in the country that has made the commitment to make the entire county a hunger free zone, providing Blessings in a Backpack across all 9 elementary schools and Children’s Academy Early Learning Center.

Many education majors finish college and move into their first positions as teachers with little to no help. This is why the Education Foundation chose to award 26 first year classroom teachers with \$100 gift cards to the Your Education Supply Store. Teachers face hundreds of dollars in out of pocket expenses to provide for their students. The Education Foundation is proud to facilitate a smoother transition into becoming a NAFC educator.
